Make Sure You Get SUNY Niagara Alerts

The NCCC ALERT text and email alert notification system will now come through as SUNY NIAGARA ALERT. If you are a faculty or staff member, or student and did not receive the test alert sent out Thursday, Feb. 22 at 2 p.m., then please go to BANNER, find NCCC Emergency Alert registration and enter your contact information to receive messages.

Use Myhub for FREE enrollment verifications!

Myhub is a free and secure online application provided by the National Student Clearinghouse. Myhub provides you with access to your verified education record from SUNY Niagara and all other colleges and universities that participate in Myhub where you also have an academic record.

Myhub offers many convenient self-service features, such as:

- Download and print enrollment, advanced registration, and "good student discount" certificates
- Order transcripts
- Add digital credentials hosted on Credly to your Myhub learner record

Through Myhub, you have lifetime access to your complete academic record of enrollment and degrees earned from participating institutions. You'll also benefit from immediate access to new capabilities and resources, which will serve you throughout your professional life, as they are added to Myhub. Place your order online through Banner Web:

- Click on Academic Transcript Order Official or
- Go to the <u>Registration & Records webpage</u> and click on the "Order Official Transcripts" button.

There is a \$10 fee for each official transcript ordered.




