College Plans for Eclipse:

The full schedule, which continues to evolve, is posted [here](#).

The college will be open April 8. However, all classes that day are cancelled. The SUNY Niagara Shuttle will NOT BE RUNNING that day due to the volume of traffic expected.

County Issues Eclipse Readiness Guide:

The presence of many observers who come to our region for the April 8 solar eclipse likely will impact Niagara County in several ways. The county has issued advice to help residents prepare for this.

- Expect heavy traffic from April 4 through April 9, especially on the day of the eclipse.
- Stock up on supplies—for example, groceries, medicine, water, eclipse viewing glasses—prior to April 4.
- Fill up vehicles' gas tanks prior to April 6.
- Avoid scheduling appointments or running errands April 8.
- All schools within the county will be closed April 8.
- Spectators who travel to western New York may overwhelm telecommunications networks and services, resulting in cellular and internet interruptions.
- The number of motorists departing eclipse events may create prolonged delays on roadways.
- The demand for first responders and law enforcement officials likely will increase.

Commencement:

Is the ceremony celebrating your graduation. Diplomas are not distributed at Commencement.

Graduation:

If you meet all academic requirements, you will find the status of your graduation at the top of your Degree Works evaluation. Simply log into Degree Works and look at the header information. Certified graduates will indicate an awarded degree status, along with the term of graduation. Evaluations will take place through early June, so please continue to check your status here. If you do not meet graduation requirements, you will receive a letter and a T-Wolves email denying graduation. You can expect to receive these notifications by the **middle of June**.

Diplomas:

Digital Diplomas will be issued which are fast, free, and sharable. The digital diploma will be emailed to you but does not replace the paper diploma. A paper diploma will be mailed to the graduate's address on file approximately 3 weeks after the digital diplomas are issued. Graduates should expect email and text notification to claim their diploma.

Each graduate will receive **two tickets to the commencement ceremony**

What time do I have to arrive on campus on Commencement Day?

Graduates are expected to arrive by 9:00 a.m. in the Arts & Media Theatre to line up for the ceremony.

No Smoking: There will be **NO SMOKING** on campus. NCCC is a tobacco-free environment.

Parking on campus: Guests for the ceremony can park in lot 1, which is located off Saunders Settlement Road (Route 31).

Names in Program Book

NCCC makes every effort to include all degree candidates' names in the Commencement program. Those who apply for Graduation after the deadline (April 29th) are not guaranteed listing in the program.

Children Require Tickets

Room capacity is based on individuals. All guests entering the Main Gym must present a guest ticket, including babies and children, even if they will sit on adult laps or in strollers.

Important Dates

May 1st Last day to order a Cap & Gown and still participate in the Commencement ceremony.

May 6th Deadline for graduating students or guests who are physically challenged and require special arrangements at the ceremony to contact Jill Faddoul, Commencement Coordinator at jmfaddoul@niagaracc.suny.edu or (716) 614-5974.

May 2nd - May 10th Students who have filed for graduation and have purchased a cap and gown can pick up their 2 (two) guest tickets at the Barnes and Noble Bookstore. (The location where you purchased your cap & gown: Sanborn or NFCI)


