## Fall 2024 - Drop/Delete Deadline:

The deadline to drop/delete Fall 2024 courses is Monday, September 23. Courses dropped on or before this date will not appear on your transcript/schedule. However, please be aware that you may incur financial liabilities. Click <u>here</u> for more details. To drop a class yourself by logging into Banner Web:

- Click on "Registration"
- Click on "Register for Classes" and select the term
- On the Registration menu, click on "Register for Classes" and select the term
- A list of registered courses will appear in the Summary section. If you cannot see the Summary section, click on "Panels" at the bottom left side of the page to expand.
- To drop a course, choose "Web Drop" or "Web drop during Penalty Period" from the drop-down next to the course you want to drop.
- Click "Submit Changes"

#### To request a course be dropped by the Enrollment Center:

- Log into Banner Web, click on Registration, Withdraw from a Class, or
- Click <u>here</u> to Drop or Withdraw From a Class, **or**
- Contact the Enrollment Center via TWolves email at <u>records@niagaracc.suny.edu</u>.

If you choose to drop a course after September 23, the course will remain on your transcript and a "W" grade will be assigned. If you have questions about dropping a course, please contact the **Student Success Center** at 716-614-6290 or email <u>studentsuccess@niagaracc.suny.edu</u>. Modular courses differ in deadlines. ## Use Myhub for FREE Enrollment Verifications:

Myhub is a free and secure online application provided by the National Student Clearinghouse. Myhub provides you with access to your verified education record from SUNY Niagara and all other colleges and universities that participate in Myhub where you also have an academic record.

Myhub offers many convenient self-service features, such as:

- · Download and print enrollment, advanced registration, and "good student discount" certificates
- Order transcripts
- · Add digital credentials hosted on Credly to your Myhub learner record

Through Myhub, you have lifetime access to your complete academic record of enrollment and degrees earned from participating institutions. You'll also benefit from immediate access to new capabilities and resources, which will serve you throughout your professional life, as they are added to Myhub. 
## Student Life Events:
