PAYMENT POLICY

SUNY Niagara requires all students to pay the full account balance by the payment due date. If you enroll in classes after the payment due date, payment in full is due at the time of registration. If your account balance is not paid in full any time after the payment due date, your course schedule may be dropped.

KNOW YOUR FINANCIAL OBLIGATION

All tuition and fees incurred as a result of course registration or other student activity are due and payable to SUNY Niagara, and are the student's responsibility to pay.

Financial aid that appears on an account is only an estimate until earned. Financial aid eligibility will change because of non-attendance, insufficient academic progress and ineligible courses Accounts with unpaid balances of \$500 or more will have a hold placed on the account prior to open registration for a subsequent term. The hold will prevent a student from registering for future classes until the account balance is reduced to below \$500.

SUNY Niagara may refer delinquent accounts to an outside collection agency for further collection efforts. The student is responsible for paying the collection agency fee, which may be based on a percentage at a maximum of 33.3333% of the delinquent account, together with all costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, SUNY Niagara incurs in such collection efforts. Student's failure to pay financial obligation may be reported to credit bureaus, which will negatively impact credit scores.

REFUNDS/WITHDRAWALS

Refunds of tuition and fees will be based on your official withdrawal date in accordance with College policy and State University of New York regulations.
