#### **ART EXHIBIT**

#### Exploration of Color in Nature

Long before Isaac Newton experimented with prisms to refract white light, people intuitively appreciated the remarkable phenomenon of color in nature. By instinct, people understand the natural essence of color, but Newton's work led the scientific understanding of the visible color spectrum. The experience of color alone, however, is one which cannot be explained scientifically. Color provides us with a sense of fascination, and I will explore this experience using the color wheel as my foundation. Utilizing traditional media such as oil pastels and colored pencils to display my observations of organic subjects, exhibiting natural color will remind us all to stay inspired and awed by the beauty.

#### The Passion of Spain

*El baile flamenco* is one of the most widely recognized Spanish dances. Flamenco dance is characterized by hand clapping, percussive footwork, and intricate arm movements. It is a highly expressive dance form with passionate emotions and facial expressions. Female flamenco dancers often wear colorful, eye-catching skirts and use hand percussion, such as cassonets, to further emphasize their movements. Flamenco dance is made up of three parts: guitar playing (*guitarra*), song (*cante*), and dance (*baile*). The dancer and musician work together to tell a story through this moving, passion-filled piece of art while connecting with the audience on a deep emotional level.

#### **Animal Training**

This project is a demonstration of basic obedience training with a dog. Dogs are a common pet and the knowledge of training is very useful. The training demonstration will consist of the steps it takes to teach a dog how to sit, lie down, and finish. This form of training, called positive reinforcement, can be used with many kinds of animals, not just dogs. A poster will add to the project with facts and general information about animal training and positive reinforcement, as well as a simplified version of the steps being taught in the demonstration. This is knowledge that will help people live happier lives with a more obedient dog. This material was learned from the animal training and animal behavior classes in the Animal Management program.
