# Join the Niagara Pride & Wellness 5K – Support LGBTQ+ Youth in Our Community!

SUNY Niagara is proud to host the 2025 Niagara Pride & Wellness 5K Fun Run/Walk on Saturday, May 10, 2025, from 9 am to 2 pm with the 5K starting at 10 am right from our campus at 3111 Saunders Settlement Rd, Sanborn, NY.

This isn't just a 5K – it's a chance to run, walk, strut, or sashay your way across the finish line while supporting a vital cause. Niagara Pride is working to raise \$30,000 to launch the first-ever LGBTQ+ Youth Drop-In Program in Niagara County. This safe and affirming space will help combat the challenges LGBTQ+ youth face – including elevated risks of depression, anxiety, substance use, and bullying. Did you know?

- LGBTQ+ youth are more likely to experience mental health challenges than their straight peers.
- A 2019 Trevor Project study found that every 45 seconds, an LGBTQ+ youth between the ages of 13–21 attempts suicide.

To show our appreciation, SUNY Niagara employees and students who register for the 5K will receive a **SUNY Niagara cooling** headband! Pick yours up in the Human Resources office in A-261 the week of May 5th.

We encourage everyone to wear their headbands during the event – not only will it help you stay cool, but it will also help identify fellow SUNY Niagara participants and show our united support as a campus community.

## Important Spring Deadline - April 29:

The deadline to request an S/U/W Grade or Withdraw from the College is Tuesday, April 29.

Withdraw from a Class – To drop a course and receive a W (withdrawal) grade as a final grade, complete the electronic <a href="Drop or Withdraw from a Course">Drop or Withdraw from a Course form</a>.

Withdraw from College (All Classes) – To withdraw online from the college and receive "X" grades for ALL of your current courses, complete the electronic Request for College Withdrawal (All Classes) form. If you completed any modular courses, you will receive the grade earned and "W" grades will be applied to all other college coursework.

Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) Grades – To elect to receive a final grade of S/U in a course, students must submit the electronic S/U grade request form which will also require approvals from the course instructor and the student's advisor. Selecting the S/U option may be beneficial to students in certain circumstances; however, students should be aware of the impact on course loads in future semesters, financial aid/academic standing implications, and the transferability of S/U grades. Both grading options may also impact eligibility for Excelsior. Please contact the Financial Aid Office for questions related to Excelsior.

Mod courses differ in deadlines – refer to the online <u>Student Calendar</u> for more information.


