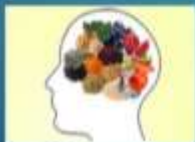

-  **May 8th : Summer Tuition Payment Due Date** - Deadline to pay your bill if you are registered for Summer 2025 courses.
-  **May 9th : Deadline to Apply for Graduation** - Last day to apply for graduation for the Spring 2025 semester. Visit sunyniagara.edu/registration-records/graduation/#How-to-apply for more information.
-  **May 12th - May 16th : Final Week of Spring Classes** - Final exams to be held during regular scheduled class times.
-  **May 17th : Commencement Ceremony** - Congratulations Graduates! Ceremony for Fall 2024, Winter 2025, potential Spring 2025 and potential Summer 2025 graduates.
-  **May 19th : Spring Final Grades Posted** - Grades available on BannerWeb after 4 pm.
-  **May 21st : Summer Full Term (12 wk) & Summer Session I (6 wk) classes begin** - Excellent opportunity to make up classes or reduce course load for future semesters!
-  **May 21st : Add/Drop period for Summer Full Term (12 wk) & Summer Session I (6 wk)** - Students can add or drop classes on their schedule anytime online in BannerWeb until 9:59 pm. *Advisement assistance available through the Student Success Center (D-102).* Last day to drop Summer Full Term & Session I class(es) on BannerWeb with 100% refund.
-  **May 21st : Non-Matriculated Registration Ends for Summer** - Both for Summer Session I (8 wk) & Full Term (12 wk).
-  **May 26th : Memorial Day** - College Closed.
-  **May 29th : Last Day to Drop for Summer Session I (6 wk)** - Last day to drop a class on BannerWeb with no academic record for Summer Session I (8 wk).
