# SUNY NIAGARA STUDENT MEAL PLAN

Students who reside in Student Housing Village will be required to choose at least to 80 meal plan. The cost of the meal plan will be over and above the room rate selected within housing. The money paid by the student will be accessed through the Student ID (swipe card) within any of the food service establishments at SUNY Niagara. Any unused meal swipes would be forfeited at the end of each academic year.

**Meal Contents:** One entrée, one side, and one beverage. This may also include single grab and go prepared meals, which can be taken back to the student’s residence and be heated in the suite.

*Points can be used at any of the food service establishments at SUNY Niagara for ala carte items at any time during the semester. Points can be replenished through adding monies to the student’s account throughout the academic semester, in the College Association Office, G-215.*
