## Fall 2025 - Drop/Delete Course Deadline:

The deadline to drop/delete Fall 2025 courses is Tuesday, September 23. Courses dropped on or before this date will not appear on your transcript/schedule. However, please be aware that you may incur financial liabilities. Click <a href="here">here</a> for more details.

### To drop a class yourself by logging into **Banner Web**:

- · Click on "Registration"
- Click on "Register for Classes" and select the term
- On the Registration menu, click on "Register for Classes" and select the term
- Click on "Panels" in the bottom left corner.
- A list of registered courses will appear in the Summary section. To drop a course, choose "Web Drop" or "Web drop during Penalty Period" from the drop-down next to the course you want to drop.
- Click "Submit Changes"

#### To request a course be dropped by the Records Office:

- Log into <u>Banner Web</u>, click on Registration, Drop/Withdraw from Course or College (All Classes), or
- Contact the Records Office via TWolves email at <a href="mailto:records@niagaracc.suny.edu">records@niagaracc.suny.edu</a>.

If you choose to drop a course after the deadline listed above, the course will remain on your transcript and a "W" grade will be assigned.

You can also go to the Records Office webpage and click on the "Order Official Transcripts" button.

The fee is \$10 plus tax for each official transcript ordered.

# BASIC NEEDS RESOURCES

The SUNY Nagara Islanc Needs webpage is designed to help students access essential services and resources. It includes The Pantry, which provides food assistance and is currently undergoing updates, and Annie's Closet, an upcoming initiative to support students with clothing needs. The webpage will also highlight the role of the SUNY Homeless Liaison, shuttle services, the Wellness Center, and various housing and transportation options, ensuring students have the support they need to thrive both academically and personally.

### **Public Safety:**

As a service-oriented group, the SUNY Niagara Public Safety Department is responsible for assisting in first aid, personal safety, CPR, AED, fire and traffic safety, crime prevention, emergency notification, lectures on various topics, and documenting incidents that occur on campus. SUNY Niagara Public Safety Department officers have the authority to ask persons for identification and to determine whether individuals have lawful business on campus. Officers may detain persons suspected of unlawful activity. They also have the authority to issue parking tickets, which are payable to the Town of Cambria. Please be sure you are parked in an area that is designated for students. The responsibility of locating a legal parking space rests with the vehicle operator. Parking tickets will be issued for those who are not in compliance with the parking rules and regulations set forth. The fact that a person parks or observes others parking in violation of any parking regulations without being cited does not mean that the regulation is not in effect. Signs are posted in each lot. 




Suicide Prevention Awareness Event hosted by Health & Wellness Center September 15 at 11:00 a.m. - 1:00 PM in the Learning Commons
