

Printing On Campus:

SUNY Niagara Print Initiative - What You Need to Know

SUNY Niagara has joined SUNY's system-wide Print Initiative to make printing more sustainable. This effort will help us reduce paper and supply use, lower carbon emissions and conserve valuable resources like trees and water.

What's Changing:

Print jobs will no longer print automatically. Instead, your job will be sent to a secure cloud queue called Pharos Print. You will then release your document at one of the four designated printer locations below using your personal passcode:

· ACE (D-201) · E-Commons · Lewis Library (D-200) · NFCI Student Computer Lab (Room 255)

Getting Started:

Visit one of the designated printer locations above and look for the "How to Set Up Your Pharos Print Account" instructions. Printing Going Forward:

When printing, select "SUNY Niagara Secure" as your printer. Go to a designated location and release your print job by entering your personal Pharos passcode directly on the printer display.

September 6th: Last day to withdraw from college and drop ALL Fall classes with 100% refund - Online through Banner Web only; modular courses differ in deadlines. September 8th : Fall Add/Drop period for students in MONDAY ONLY classes - Records Office (A-161); financial liability may apply. Advisement assistance available through the Student Success Center (D-102) for students who want to speak with an advisor before changing their schedule. September 23rd : Last day to drop a Fall class on Banner Web with no academic record - Financial liability may apply; modular courses differ in deadlines.

September 24th: W (Withdrawal) grades begin for Fall - Modular courses differ in deadlines.

September 2nd – 19th: CRISIS!!! Missing classes during the first three weeks – Talk to your instructors, academic advisor, or the Student Success Center located in the Learning Commons or at (716) 614-6290.

Attendance Recorded - Faculty must report student attendance – especially during these weeks. Failure to attend class(es) may result in a final grade of a Wiwithdrawal or Xiwithdrawal from college. This may also reduce your financial aid and leave you with a bill.
