# Fall 2025 - Drop/Delete Course Deadline:

The deadline to drop/delete Fall 2025 courses is Tuesday, September 23. Courses dropped on or before this date will not appear on your transcript/schedule. However, please be aware that you may incur financial liabilities. Click <a href="here">here</a> for more details.

# To drop a class yourself by logging into **Banner Web**:

- Click on "Registration"
- Click on "Register for Classes" and select the term
- On the Registration menu, click on "Register for Classes" and select the term
- Click on "Panels" in the bottom left corner.
- A list of registered courses will appear in the Summary section. To drop a course, choose "Web Drop" or "Web drop during Penalty Period" from the drop-down next to the course you want to drop.
- Click "Submit Changes"

### To request a course be dropped by the Records Office:

- Log into Banner Web, click on Registration, Drop/Withdraw from Course or College (All Classes), or
- Contact the Records Office via TWolves email at records@niagaracc.suny.edu.

If you choose to drop a course after the deadline listed above, the course will remain on your transcript and a "W" grade will be assigned.







September 1st: Labor Day - College Closed.



**September 2<sup>nd</sup>: Fall classes Begin -** Be sure to check your schedule in Banner Web to make sure that room locations or modalities have not changed!



September 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>: Fall Add/Drop period – Students can add or drop classes on their schedule anytime online in Banner Web until 11:59 PM on September 5<sup>th</sup> (financial liability may apply). Advisement assistance available through the Student Success Center (D-102) for students who want to speak with an advisor before changing their schedule.



September 6<sup>th</sup>: Last day to withdraw from college and drop ALL Fall classes with 100% refund – Online through Banner Web only; modular courses differ in deadlines.



September 8<sup>th</sup>: Fall Add/Drop period for students in MONDAY ONLY classes – Records Office (A-161); financial liability may apply.

Advisement assistance available through the Student Success Center (D-102) for students who want to speak with an advisor before changing their schedule.



September 23<sup>rd</sup>: Last day to drop a Fall class on Banner Web with no academic record – Financial liability may apply; modular courses differ in deadlines.



September 24th: W (Withdrawal) grades begin for Fall - Modular courses differ in deadlines.



September 2<sup>nd</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup>: CRISIS!!! Missing classes during the first three weeks – Talk to your instructors, academic advisor, or the Student Success Center located in the Learning Commons or at (716) 614-6290.
