Rental Books are Due Back to the Bookstore Friday, December 19!

All Wolf Packed books are rentals, with the exception of a select few workbooks. Check your student email or stop by the bookstore to see what books you owe.

An email will be sent with buy-out prices for those who wish to buy out their rental books, or an employee can check in store. Buy-outs can only be done before the late fees hit, about five days after the rental due date. After that, students must either return the book or pay the late fee + replacement fee. Late fees will stay on the student's bookstore account until the book is returned, and a collections agency will begin calling within 2 months of the book being late. Avoid unnecessary stress and return your books on time!!

Sanborn bookstore is open Mon & Tues 9-5, Wed & Thurs 8-4, and Friday 9-4 until the semester ends. We are open Mon & Tues 12/22 & 12/23 9am-4pm, CLOSED 12/24-1/1, and Open 9-4 Friday 1/2 for winter classes.

NFCI bookstore is open its regular 9am-3pm M-F until the semester ends. Open 9am-3pm 12/22 & 12/23, Closed 12/24 – 1/2, Open 9am-3pm 1/5.

The **Rental Drop-Box** on Sanborn campus is now open! For after-hours returns, please utilize the drop-box located right outside the doors at of the Sanborn bookstore. Be sure to fill out the provided paper slip and enclose your book(s) in the plastic bags so that we are able to check the books in. Books turned in without a name cannot be checked in, will go in our "Mystery Pile", and late fees will still appear on the student account. NFCI students should make every effort to return their books to the NFCI bookstore, but if absolutely necessary can utilize the drop-box on the Sanborn campus also.

Rental books can also be **shipped** back! To purchase a shipping label, log onto your account at niagaracc.bncollege.com. If shipping on your own through USPS mail/Fed Ex/ UPS, please be sure to address the package to "Barnes & Noble Bookstore at SUNY Niagara, 3111 Saunders Settlement Rd, Sanborn, NY 14132". With either shipping method, please add a sticky note with your name and phone number inside the package, so we know who the books belong to.

Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) Grades – To elect to receive a final grade of S/U in a course, students must submit the electronic <u>S/U grade request</u> form which will also require approvals from the course instructor and the student's advisor. Selecting the S/U option may be beneficial to students in certain circumstances; however, students should be aware of the impact on course loads in future semesters, financial aid/academic standing implications, and the transferability of S/U grades. Both grading options may also impact eligibility for Excelsior. Please contact Financial Aid for questions related to Excelsior.
