Academic Center for Excellence (ACE) Homepage:

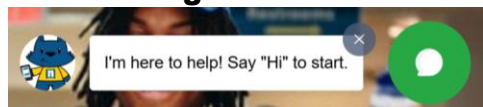

Wolf Packed Textbook Orders: Remember to log in and submit your order for physical textbooks!

- All students should log in to the Wolf Packed site (either through the link in their email or the yellow sign-in button at sunyniagara.edu/academics/wolfpacked) to view what is required for their classes. All course materials adopted by the professor are labeled either physical or digital. The order must be submitted for any physical books, whereas digital books are automatically available in Brightspace.
- OER courses do not show up on the Wolf Packed site at all; professors will provide what is needed for the course (credit is applied to the student bill).
- Students interested in opting out of Wolf Packed need to do so through the link on the Wolf Packed website stated above. February 10th is the last day to do so. Students need to be aware that access to digital materials in Brightspace will be taken away after 2/10 if they opted out.

Financial Aid is active for those that have funds designated to the bookstore until **2/19**. Please bring your student ID and ask a bookstore employee to see how much you may have to spend before purchasing. Financial Aid can also be used on the bookstore website (niagaracc.bncollege.com). Please note that submitting an order online does not automatically charge your Financial Aid account but submits it for payment review by a bookstore manager. If there are not enough funds in your account, we will not be able to process the order.
