Need to Order an Official Transcript?

Place your order online through [Banner Web](#):

- Go to the Student Records card
- Click on Academic Transcript - Order Official

You can also go to the [Records Office webpage](#) and click on the "Order Official Transcripts" button.

The fee is \$10 plus tax for each official transcript ordered.

Please note: Unofficial transcripts are free of charge and may be obtained by logging into [Banner Web](#); click on the Student Records tab; choose Academic Transcripts – View Unofficial.

Use Myhub for FREE Enrollment Verifications

Myhub is a free and secure online application provided by the National Student Clearinghouse. Myhub provides you with access to your verified education record from SUNY Niagara and all other colleges and universities that participate in Myhub where you also have an academic record.

Myhub offers many convenient self-service features, such as:

- Download and print enrollment, advanced registration, and "good student discount" certificates
- Order transcripts

Through Myhub, you have lifetime access to your complete academic record of enrollment and degrees earned from participating institutions. You'll also benefit from immediate access to new capabilities and resources, which will serve you throughout your professional life, as they are added to Myhub. Visit <https://www.myhub.org> today to create your account or log into Banner Web, click on Student Records, and choose "Enrollment Verification – National Student Clearinghouse".

Spring 2026 - Drop/Delete Course Deadline:

The deadline to drop/delete Spring 2026 courses is TOMORROW...February 10th. Courses dropped on or before this date will not appear on your transcript/schedule. However, please be aware that you may incur [financial liabilities](#).

To drop a class yourself by logging into [Banner Web](#):

- On the Registration card, click "Register for Classes" and select the term
- On the Registration menu, click on "Register for Classes" and select the term
- Click on "Panels" in the bottom left corner.
- A list of registered courses will appear in the Summary section. To drop a course, choose "Web Drop" or "Web drop during Penalty Period" from the drop-down next to the course you want to drop.
- Click "Submit Changes"

To request a course be dropped by the Records Office:

- Log into [Banner Web](#), click on Registration, Drop/Withdraw from Course or College (All Classes), or
- Contact the Records Office via TWolves email at records@niagaracc.suny.edu.

If you choose to drop a course after the deadline listed above, the course will remain on your transcript and a "W" grade will be assigned. If you have questions about dropping a course, please contact the **Student Success Center** at 716-614-6290 or email studentsuccess@niagaracc.suny.edu. Modular courses differ in deadlines. Wolf Packed Textbook Orders: There are many textbook orders still ready for pickup! Be sure to check your T-Wolves email to see if you have gotten a reminder about an order being ready. After 3 reminder emails, the books will be returned (this does not impact the Wolf Packed fee at all).

Wolf Packed Opt Out ends February 10th. After this date students are no longer able to opt out of the Wolf Packed program. Opting out must be done through the link at sunyniagara.edu/academics/wolfpacked (in the FAQ section). Please note that within a few days of opting out, access to any digital material in Brightspace will also be lost.

Financial Aid is active for those that have funds designated to the bookstore until **February 19th**.

Please bring your student ID and ask a bookstore employee to see how much you may have to spend before purchasing. Financial Aid can also be used on the bookstore website (niagaracc.bncollege.com).

Please note that submitting an order online does not automatically charge your Financial Aid account but submits it for payment review by a bookstore manager. If there are not enough funds in your bookstore account, we will not be able to process the order. After February 19th, no purchases or returns can be made using Financial Aid.
