LAST WEEK TO PURCHASE CAP & GOWN! Deadline Friday, May 1st

Commencement: Cap & Gown Bundles are available in the Bookstore (Sanborn & NFCI)!

Cost is \$47.94 for the cap, gown, and tassel (no tax).

Students who are eligible to graduate must purchase their cap & gown in the bookstore by Friday, MAY 1ST to participate in the commencement ceremony on May 16th.

For those who have purchased the cap & gown, **tickets** are able to be picked up at the bookstore (campus where cap & gown was purchased) **on Tuesday, May 5th – ID is Required.**

Textbook Rentals are due back to the Bookstore by Friday, May 15th!!

- All physical Wolf Packed textbooks are rentals and are due back to the bookstore by the end of the semester (5/15). Return books at the front counter (both campuses) during open hours.
- A drop-box will be available by Monday, May 4th on Sanborn Campus for after-hours returns. Be sure to follow the posted directions and fill out the provided paper slip. We cannot check books in without a name. Books dropped in with no information attached will go into our “Mystery Pile” and charges will remain on the student’s bookstore account.
- NFCI students should make every effort to return their books at NFCI during open hours. If absolutely necessary, utilize the drop-box on Sanborn Campus.
- Have overdue books from a previous semester still? Bring them back! Once we have the book we can erase the late fees from your bookstore account.
- Looking to Buy Out a rented textbook? An email will be sent out with a link to buy out the book online, or students do it in store. Buyouts can only be done before the late fees hit the student account, approximately 5 days after the semester ends. After that point, students need to either return the book or pay the replacement fee.

Don't Forget...Important S/U/W/X Spring Deadline – Tuesday, April 28

The deadline to request an S/U/W Grade or Withdraw from the College is Tuesday, April 28.

Withdraw from at least one Class or All Classes – SPRING DEADLINE IS APRIL 28 To drop a course and receive a W (withdrawal) grade as a final grade, or to withdraw online from the college and receive “X” grades for **ALL** of your current courses, complete the electronic [Request to Withdraw from Course or College \(All Classes\)](#) form. If you completed any modular courses, you will receive the grade earned, and “W” grades will be applied to all other college coursework.

DEADLINE FOR Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) Grades IS APRIL 28 – To elect to receive a final grade of S/U in a course, students must submit the electronic [S/U grade request](#) form which will also require approvals from the course instructor and the student’s advisor. Selecting the S/U option may be beneficial to students in certain circumstances; however, students should be aware of the impact on course loads in future semesters, financial aid/academic standing implications, and the transferability of S/U grades. Both grading options may also impact eligibility for Excelsior. Please contact Financial Aid for questions related to Excelsior. Mod course deadlines differ – refer to the online [Student Calendar](#) for more information.
