



## Turn Your EMS Training into College Credit

**EMT • AEMT • Paramedic**

**Train at SUNY Niagara. Finish your degree at Empire State University.**

Students who complete EMT, AEMT, or Paramedic training at SUNY Niagara County Community College may be eligible to earn college credit toward an associate or bachelor's degree at SUNY Empire State University.

---

### How It Works

1. Complete your EMS training at SUNY Niagara County Community College
2. Earn your NYS or National EMT certification
3. Apply to SUNY Empire
4. Request credit for your EMT licensure
5. Apply credits toward your degree

---

### Credit You Can Earn

Students receive credit based on their highest level of licensure:

EMS CERTIFICATION	COLLEGE CREDIT AWARDED
EMERGENCY MEDICAL RESPONDER / FIRST RESPONDER	8 credits
EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN (EMT-B)	16 credits
ADVANCED EMT (AEMT)	20 credits
PARAMEDIC	40 credits

- ✓ Credits may apply to Anatomy & Physiology, skills-based coursework, and advanced EMS learning
- ✓ Liberal and advanced-level credit included where appropriate
- ✓ Credit is awarded once per licensure level

---

### Important Notes

- Students receive credit only for their highest EMS certification
- If you earn a higher certification later, additional credits may be awarded
- If you completed EMS coursework at a community college, some credits may overlap  
→ Our office can help review your options

---

### What You'll Need

To receive credit, students must provide documentation of current certification:

- New York State EMS Certification *or*
- National Registry of EMTs (NREMT) certification

(Some students may also be eligible for recertification credit with documentation.)
