



Turn Your Pharmacy Technician Training into College Credit

Train at SUNY Niagara. Finish your degree at Empire State University.

Students who complete **Pharmacy Technician Training** at **SUNY Niagara County Community College** and successfully pass the **PTCB certification exam** may be eligible to earn **college credit** toward an **associate or bachelor's degree** at **SUNY Empire State University**.

How It Works

1. Complete your Pharmacy Technician training at SUNY Niagara County Community College
2. Earn your Pharmacy Technician Certification (CPhT) by passing the PCTB exam.
3. Apply to SUNY Empire
4. Request credit for your PTCB License
5. Apply credits toward your degree

Credit You Can Earn

Degree seeking students may earn:

Pharmacy Technician Certification	College Credit Awarded
Pharmacy Technology	6 credits

- ✓ These introductory-level credits may apply to Allied Health or Science, Math, and Technology programs.
- ✓ Students in other degree programs may be able to use these credits as general learning/elective credit.

Important Notes

- Students with experience working in a retail pharmacy may be eligible for additional individualized Credit for Prior Learning in topics like Customer Service.
- If you have completed Pharmacy related coursework at a college or university, some credits may overlap.
