The licensed massage therapist (LMT) plays an important role in the wellness of their clients. Massage therapy is the manipulation of muscles and other soft tissues of the body for therapeutic purposes. Clients of the LMT benefit from decreased stress and increased relaxation, reduced pain, decreased muscle soreness and tension, improved circulation, improved energy and alertness, lowered heart rate and blood pressure, and improved immune function.
